- Cataracts Do they cause ocular health problems? Why? Should I refer cataracts? How do I explain this to an owner?
- Glaucomas Unraveling some of the mysteries around this disease and how to explain to owners the treatment and prognosis.

Rick commenced his veterinary specialty training in the US in 1999, and in 2002 moved to Barcelona to obtain a European veterinary qualification. He completed his residency training in ophthalmology at the University of Glasgow and the Eye Veterinary Clinic in the UK in 2005. Then, he headed the ophthalmology service in a private practice until late 2011 when he joined the Royal Veterinary College (RVC) of the University of London to established and direct the Ophthalmology Service and an ECVO Ophthalmology Residency program. He returned to private practice and settled in Holland (Specialistische Dierenkliniek Utrecht - SDU) in 2017. Rick lectures around the world, is an Editorial Board Member of the Veterinary Ophthalmology journal since 2010, and has active research interest in the cornea, corneal surgery, cataract surgery and glaucoma.
